SUBJECT:- APPLICATION TO JOIN THE FEDERATION


1. At a meeting of the Army Sub Aqua Diving Association (Hong Kong) held on Wednesday 27 March 1974 there was a unanimous vote that we should join your Federation.
2. It is therefore, with great pleasure, I would ask you to accept us as a new member of the Federation.
3. Our aims, as you know, are the same as all present members, in that we wish to become part of the organisation that links all clubs in Hong Kong and to establish friendly and loyal co-operation.
4. We would ask however that you realise our three Army clubs are mainly military personnel and that they are only here, in Hong Kong, for the short period of two years. This will mean many changes in our Committee members and also the divers themselves.
5. At present the three clubs in our Army Association are the JOINT SERVICES SUB AQUA CLUB who operate from VICTORIA Barracks, and are 60 strong. The Kowloon Services Sub Aqua Club who operates from Blackdown Barracks and are approximately 40 strong and the New Territories Club who operate from Sek Kong Camp and are approx 50 strong. Full lists of members, appointments and contact numbers will be sent to you shortly.
6. In view of the fact that 3 clubs are being represented may we ask that one member from each club sit on the Committee.
7. I would also mention that EVERY member of our clubs are BSAC members and trained to their standards.
8. Hoping this is the beginning of a long and happy association between all military and civilian divers.
